



What work could I do?

As one of the largest growers of berries in the UK, the Hall Hunter Partnership has many jobs available from April through November. Most people who join the business start as pickers. There are other job opportunities too and of course possibilities for promotion. The company has a long and established reputation for running its farms like a large family, where everyone is cared for and respected. We are proud that over 70% of our current team have worked for us before.

We like to employ motivated, passionate and energetic people, who are keen to work on the farms learning about the fruit and the way we harvest. Picking fruit can be hard work and sometimes require long days but it is fun working alongside new friends and there is the potential to make good money.

In the height of the season we offer extra working hours to give you the opportunity to earn more whilst you are here.

How much will I get paid?

Your pay will be determined by:

- How much you pick each day
- The quality of berries you pick

You will receive holiday pay and have UK taxes & national insurance deducted. You will be paid weekly directly into your UK bank account. You will also be given a pay slip showing what you have earned previous week less any deductions.

The days when work may be available and the hours worked are crop and weather dependent. You will normally work up to 6 days a week, with activities arranged for you to participate in, if you'd like, when you have a day off.

The current (2023) minimum wage in the UK is £10.42 per hour, overtime will be paid at a rate of £13.03 after 48h. In 2022, on average, our pickers earned £512 per week.





Accommodation

Accommodation is available for all of our workers on the farms should you wish to use it. It is in self-contained mobile homes (caravans) sleeping 6 per home.

All caravans are fully furnished to a high standard with beds, wardrobes, table, chairs and appliances (fridge, cooker & heater). They are all well maintained and have picnic tables outside for use during warmer weather and sheds to store your outdoor clothes. Bedding is provided.

Each farm has a camp warden who will help you and support you with anything you need and make sure your stay with us is enjoyable. The cost of living onsite in one of these caravans is just £63.70 per week per person, which includes all utility bills and super-fast WiFi.

On all the farms there are free washing machines, a small shop selling English and Eastern European food and other essentials, a gym and most sites have canteen that provides hot food at a very reasonable price.

Life Outside Work...

Your time at HHP is as much about the friends you make and the fun you have as the work.

We have a friendly, family style atmosphere at all of our sites. We organise regular sightseeing trips and visits to the local town and supermarket, arrange sporting events, hold parties and BBQs. Our camps have football and volleyball pitches.

We like to create a nice friendly environment for you to live and will support you as best as we can during your stay. We think we do it better than any others, that's why so many people come back each year.
